## **AUTHORIZED IDENTIFICATION**

In accordance with Sec. 53(1) of the *Local Authorities Election Act* (Proof of Elector Eligibility) and Sec. 95(1)(a)(ii) of the *Election Act*, **in order to vote, an elector must produce one piece of identification that establishes both the elector's name and current residential address.**

An elector may vote after producing **Government Issued Identification** containing the elector's photograph, current residential address and name. This includes an Operator's (Driver's) Licence or an Alberta Identification Card.

Other forms of **Authorized Identification** with an elector's name and current residential address are:

- Attestation of Residence issued by the landlord of a Commercial Property Management Company
- Attestation of Residence issued by the responsible authority of a First Nations band or reserve
- Attestation of Residence issued by the responsible authority of a Supportive Living Facility or Treatment Center
- Bank/credit card statement or personal cheque
- Correspondence issued by a school, college or university
- Government cheque or cheque stub
- Income/property tax assessment notice
- Insurance policy or coverage card
- Letter from a public curator, public guardian or public trustee
- One of the following, issued by the responsible authority of a shelter or soup kitchen:
  - Attestation of residence
  - Letter of stay
  - Admission form, or
  - Statement of benefits
- Pension Plan statement of benefits, contributions or participation
- Residential lease or mortgage statement
- Statement of government benefits, for example:
  - Employment insurance
  - Old-age security
  - Social assistance,
  - Disability support, or
  - Child tax benefit
- Utility bill, for example:
  - Telephone
  - Public Utilities Commission
  - Television, or
  - Hydro, gas or water
- Vehicle ownership, registration or insurance certificate
